

Literacy

At Beverley School we use 'Letters and Sounds Six-phase Teaching Programme' to teach phonics starting with environmental sound recognition activities of phase 1 in the Early Years Department. The Oxford Reading Scheme is used to provide a structured approach to reading, supplemented with non-reading scheme books relevant to the pupils' interests and reading level.

Some of the literacy interventions we use are: Write Dance, Disco Dough and Active Phonics. Some targeted pupils have the opportunity to participate in 1:1 work for phonics and literacy as appropriate. Emergent writing is encouraged throughout the curriculum and all children have their own specific next steps in reading and writing.
