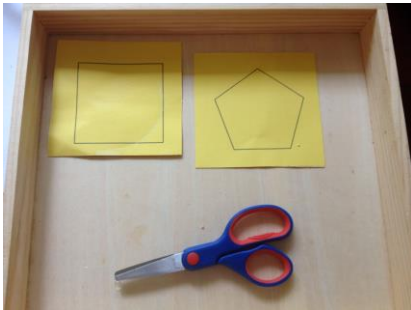


Fine motor activities – 23.3.2020

Here are some practical fine motor activities to practise at home. These activities will also encourage aspects of the English and Mathematics curriculum.



All the money - Empty a money box, sort the coins into colour or different types of coin before posting them into a money box/bottle one at a time.



Cutting shapes - Get an adult to draw shapes on pieces of paper. What is it called – match shapes or to the correct name of the shape. Count how many sides each shape has. Children to cut out the different shapes – with support/supervision. Sort all the shapes.



Making amounts - Set out 10 cupcake cases/alternative containers and label with a number. Use your fingers or tweezers to pick up pieces of pasta and put in the containers. Put the right amount in each container. Or make small balls of playdough and do the same.
