Dear Parents,

As we start a new year and a new term we would like to remind all families about the covid measures in place to keep students and staff safe in school.

Face masks

- These should be worn [unless exempt] by all students & staff in communal areas [unless seated to eat/drink] and, as before, on public and home to school dedicated transport.
- Secondary students will also need to wear them in classrooms until 26th January 2022 owing to the new measures announced yesterday

Teaching

- We will continue to provide face to face teaching and are not required to undertake whole school online learning. However, as before, work will continue to be set for those who are required to isolate and for those who have the virus and for whom no symptoms are apparent.

Self-Isolation

- Attendance in school is still required and there is no requirement to self-isolate, if vaccinated or under 18 & 6months, if in close contact with a person who has a Covid, unless the staff member or student is showing symptoms and then they should access a PCR test

Testing

- We encourage you to continue to test your child twice each week using the LFT kits provided
- We have made the decision to continue with face to face meetings and therefore all visitors who need to come into school should make an appointment and are requested to take a LF test.

Additional Measures

- We will encourage hand washing and the use of hand sanitiser within school. Please can you encourage the same at home.
- Windows remain open in classrooms and student may wear coats if ambient temperatures fall.

January return

- We would like to welcome all students and staff back into school on Tuesday the 4th but we would encourage everyone to take an LFT test before returning to school, to support the welfare of colleagues and peers.
