Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you all for your support since the start of term. I would like to give you a few updates:

1. Class Closures

Due to high numbers of staff absent due to Covid, we have had to close classes in some instances. We aim to do this for a few days at a time, to utilise staff and keep classrooms safe. We are following DfE guidance when making these decisions. Work packs are being sent home. Please see Class Dojo and Seesaw for updates. Thank you for your support with this, it is really appreciated.

2. Covid regulations

Due to changes in gov.uk guidance, from Monday 17 January, students who are self-isolating are able to reduce their isolation period if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 **and** day 6 and they do not have a temperature. [Day one is the following day on which symptoms begin or the day after a positive test has been taken. Tests need to be taken 24 hours apart but if the second test on Day 6 is taken before school starts, students can join school on that day]

3. Outdoor Clothing

The field is really muddy and wet at the moment. Can you please send in outdoor footwear, so the students can change their shoes. The field is a great resource and it's vital for student wellbeing; outdoor clothing would reduce the amount of mud on school shoes and the school carpets-so thank you for your support with this.
