

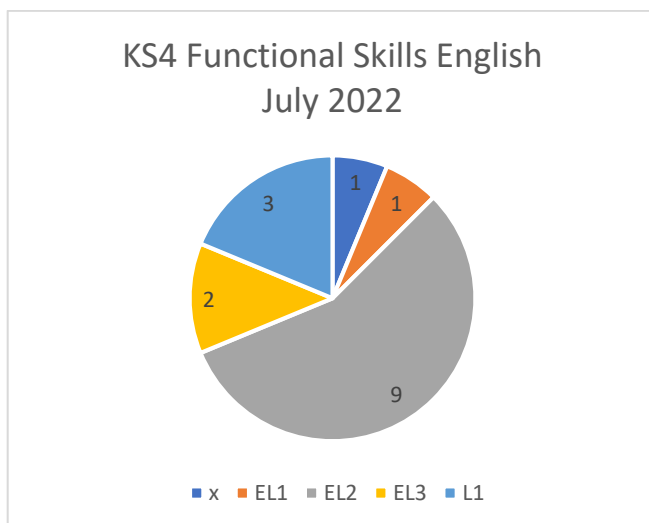

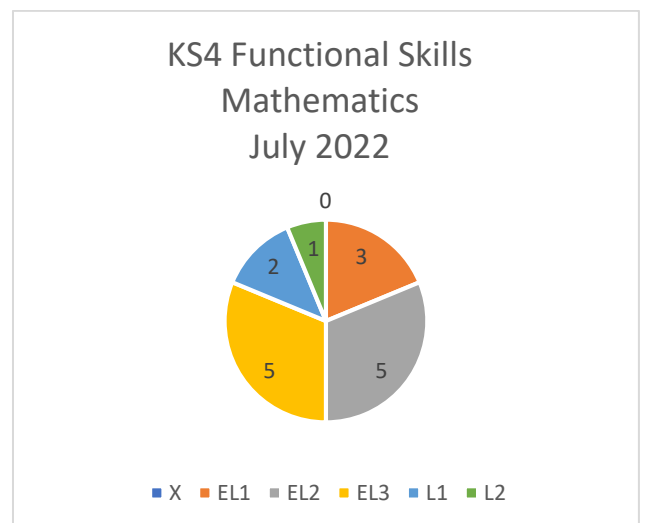
### 2021 Key Stage 4 Results



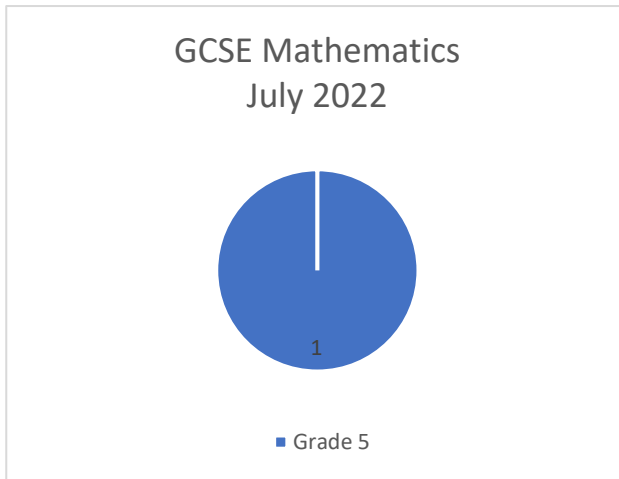
### 2022 Key Stage 4 Results

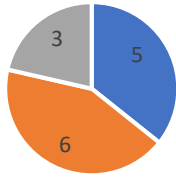

### Key Stage 4 2022 Analysis

- we have significantly increased the accreditation offer over 2021-2022 and will continuously refine and adapt according to cohort needs
- NCFE accreditation has been replaced with more appropriate Functional Skills qualifications
- 100% of students who achieved Level 2 in Functional Skills Mathematics have started an FE Level 2 course
- two Year 10 students also achieved a Level 1 Functional Skills qualification in Mathematics
- 67% of students who achieved a Level 1 in Functional Skills English are now attending Middlesbrough College studying:
  - Sports Course Level 2
  - Pre-Uniform Level 1
- in 2020-21, no Year 11 students left Beverley School to attend FE/ college and none undertook any Functional Skills or GCSE examinations
- the goal is for our more able students to move on to Level 2 qualifications in FE or equivalent sector
- all 2022 leavers have started their respective course at Middlesbrough College

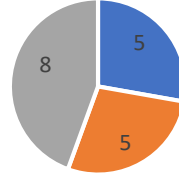

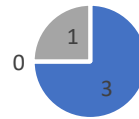
### Functional Skills English Level 1 July 2022

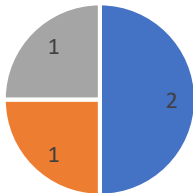
### Functional Skills Mathematics Level 1 July 2022

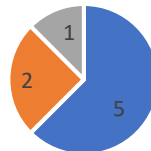
### GCSE Mathematics July 2022

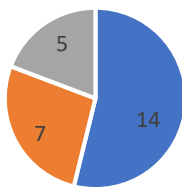
### ASDAN Personal Social Development Level 1 July 2022

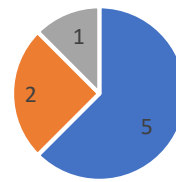
### ASDAN Life Skills Challenges July 2022

## Key Stage 5 Analysis

- NCFE Awards have been replaced by the more appropriate ASDAN personal Social Development Level 1 course
- we have significantly increased the accreditation offer over 2021-2022 and will continuously refine and adapt according to cohort needs
- 100% of Year 12 cohort entered achieved Level 1 in Functional Skills English
- 100% of GCSE cohort achieved a Pass (Grades 2, 2, 3 and 5)
- 100% of Year 12 cohort entered achieved a Level 1 in Functional Skills Maths
- 4 students left school to attend an FE provider at the end of the year
- 1 Year 14 student has started the Foundation Level Animal Care course at Askham Bryan
- the goal is to prepare our students for FE/ College at the Pre-Foundation, Foundation, Level 1 and Level 2 stage, when they are ready to move on
- 100% of those Year 12 students who achieved a Level 1 in Functional Skills Maths, Functional Skills English, Personal Social Development and a GCSE pass, have left Beverley School for Middlesbrough college to begin the following courses:
  - Level 1 Media
  - Level 1 Construction
  - VOC Steps to Public Services

### **Leavers Destination Data**

- 2020-21 leavers percentage still in education, employment, social care and training is 100%. One (11%) had deferred their destination placement for the first year due to health reasons but is now attending
- 2021-22 leavers percentage still in education, employment, social care and training is 100%

### **Follow up Destination Data**

The Gatsby guidance is to follow up for 3 years based around school leaders.
